Whether you're seeking a golfer's paradise or the ultimate vacation destination, look no farther than The Renaissance Resort at World Golf Village. Ideally situated in the heart of the beautifully landscaped 6,300-acre World Golf Village in St. Augustine, Fla., the award-winning resort offers a wealth of amenities that will please any guest.

Among the many resort offerings are two extraordinary 18-hole championship courses that were designed by the legends of the game. King & Bear is the only course in the world designed jointly by Arnold Palmer ("The King") and Jack Nicklaus ("The Bear"). This picturesque 7,279-yard course features loblolly pines and open meadows on the front nine, and impressive 200-year-old oak trees throughout the back nine. The signature features of the course include its placid lakes edged with large coquina rocks and the striking incorporation of rock into several bunkers and cart paths. The course challenges amateurs and pros alike with five sets of tees and a course rating of 75.2.

Slammer & Squire is named for legendary hall of famers "Slammin'" Sam Snead and Gene "The Squire" Sarazen. They partnered with architect Bobby Weed to create this impressive par-72 tree-lined course that features gentle rolling fairways and challenging lakes. The 6,939-yard course, with a course rating of 73.8 and a slope of 135, is distinguished by memorable par 3s, as well as for its preservation of the woodlands, wetlands and natural beauty of St. Augustine.

Both courses feature such on-course amenities as chilled apples on the first and 10th holes, complimentary range balls and Global Positioning Systems (GPS) in every cart.
